**Rosters**

Each team is required to complete a roster form. Only players listed on the official team roster will be eligible to play for said team. All rosters will be held on file in the Business Office. Completed rosters must be turned in with a team deposit. The team coach has until the start of the team’s fourth game to make any roster changes. All rosters are frozen from that point on. The team coach must meet with the referee prior to each game and turn in player passes for all coaches/players who are present. Only those individuals who are listed on the roster may be on the playing field/team bench. Spectators must remain outside the field for the duration of the game.

**Double Rostering**

No player is allowed to play on more than one team in same age group. Also, players are allowed to play up an age group providing it is in a lower division than what they are currently playing. Example: if a player plays in Girls U12A, she can only play in a Girls U14B or C division. If a team is suspected of double-rostering the office staff should be notified during the course of game-play; please do not wait until the game is over. The team coach will be responsible for checking off all players present on the referee game-sheet prior to each game. It is the responsibility of the team coach that the roster is accurate. Any coach found with an illegal player will be suspended from the premises for one full calendar year. Any player found double rostering will receive a warning. A second offense for a player is a 1 year suspension.

**League Fees**

A non-refundable \$200 deposit is required to secure a spot in any session. No team will be scheduled without a deposit. Team balances must be paid-in-full prior to the start of the team’s first game. No team will play if the league payment is not paid-in-full.

**Schedules**

Coaches are informed approximately one week before the league’s start date of their first game time. Complete schedules will be available online on the day of your first game. Wide World will do our best to accommodate scheduling requests providing they are received at least 3 weeks prior to the first game and that they are not unfair to any other team in the league. Coaches will receive an email if there are any schedule revisions and are responsible for checking the website for any schedule changes.

**PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT, RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK**

BY SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT YOU MAY BE WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE.

**TO:** The Complex (“Complex”) and the League (“League”) and their owners, officers, directors, agents, employees and/or representatives:

**ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I am aware that sport-play involves certain inherent risks, dangers, and hazards, which can result in serious personal injury or death. I am also aware that sports Complexes contain potential dangers to the sport-playing public. As such, I hereby freely agree to assume and accept any and all known and unknown risks of injury while participating in sports activities. I further recognize and acknowledge that the risks inherent in sport-play can be greatly reduced by: taking lessons, abiding by league and/or complex rules/regulations and using common sense.

**RELEASE AND WAIVER OF CLAIMS AGREEMENT:** In consideration of allowing me to participate in the League’s sport-play activities at the Complex, I hereby agree as follows:

1. **TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** that I have or may in the future have against the Complex and/or the League resulting from the League’s activities at the Complex.
2. **TO RELEASE** the Complex from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I may suffer, or that my next of kin may suffer, as a result in my participation in the activity described in this Agreement, due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence of breach of contract on the part of the Complex and/or the League in the operation, supervision, design or maintenance of the Complex.

**ARBITRATION:** In further consideration of allowing me to participate in the League’s sport activities in the Complex, I hereby agree to submit to binding arbitration any and all claims which I believe I may have against the Complex and/or the League arising from the League’s activities at the Complex. The arbitration shall be pursuant to the rules of the America Arbitration Association. The arbitrators shall apply the Federal Rules of Evidence to all proceedings.

Arbitration shall be commenced within one (1) year from the date on which any alleged claim first arose. Further, the arbitration shall be held in the town where the Complex is located, unless otherwise mutually agreed to by all the parties. The submission to the American Arbitration Association shall be unlimited and the arbitration award may be enforced by any court of competent jurisdiction.

**BINDING EFFECT OF AGREEMENT:** In the event of my death or incapacity, this Agreement shall be effective and binding upon heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives.

**ENTIRE AGREEMENT:** In entering into this Agreement, I am not relying upon any oral or written representation other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT (ON REVERSE SIDE) I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE THE COMPLEX AND THE LEAGUE
